## **Sacramental Life of our Parish**

**Baptism for children** (*under the age of 7*) is celebrated in English on the first three Sundays at 1 pm; in Spanish on the last Sunday of the month at 1 pm; in Kreyol on the 3rd Saturday at 1 pm. Parents attend a preparation session on the first Monday of the month from 8 to 9:30 pm in the church. Please call the Parish Center (334-0021) to make arrangements to speak to one of our priests or deacons about your child's upcoming baptism.

### **Celebration of Marriage**

Please call the Parish Center (334-0021) at least six months in advance to make arrangements for an interview with one of our parish deacons or priests who will meet with the engaged couple, set the time and date of the wedding, and make arrangements for our parish marriage preparation program.

### **Rite of Christian Initiation**

Adults who have never been baptized are prepared for the reception of the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) through the RCIA process. Other adults may have already been baptized, but are seeking to receive Eucharist and/or Confirmation. Those interested in knowing more about the process of becoming a full member of the Catholic Church are invited to call Sister Ann Horn at 516-334-0021, ext. 353. Parents who have school-aged children who have never been baptized are also invited to speak to Sister Ann about their process of preparation for these sacraments.

### **Sacraments of School Age Children**

Our parish faith formation program prepares children for the celebration of the sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation, and Confirmation. The norm is that children receive a two-year preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist (normally celebrated in the second grade) and a two-year preparation program for Confirmation (normally celebrated in the eighth grade). Our religious education program deepens the experience of faith and religious formation in the years between the celebrations of these sacraments.

Parents who have children older than first grade and are seeking to have them receive the sacraments of Eucharist (First Communion), Reconciliation or Confirmation are asked to call the Religious Education office.

### **Communion to the Sick and Homebound**

Anyone who is not able to attend Mass because of frailty, chronic or temporary illness, or admission to hospice can have Holy Communion brought to them at home on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to make arrangements for a lay minister to bring holy communion.

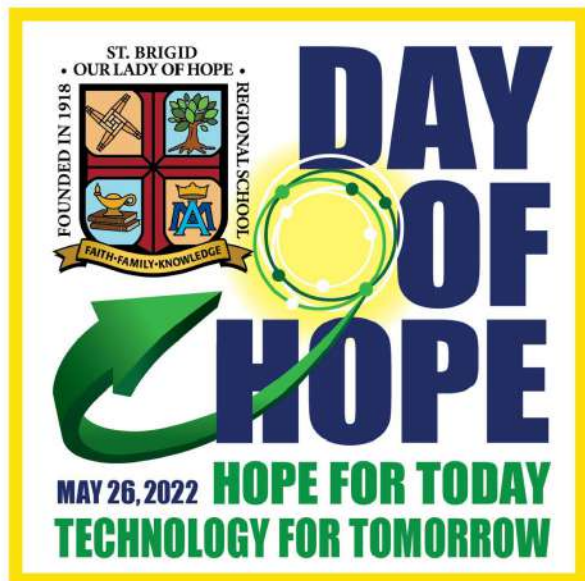

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

## May 29th - Seventh Sunday of Easter

John 17:20-26

Lifting up his eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed saying:

"Holy Father, I pray not only for them,  
but also for those who will believe in me through their word,  
so that they may all be one,  
as you, Father, are in me and I in you,  
that they also may be in us,  
that the world may believe that you sent me.

And I have given them the glory you gave me,  
so that they may be one, as we are one,  
I in them and you in me,  
they may be brought to perfection as one,  
that the world may know that you sent me,  
and that you loved them even as you loved me.

Father, they are your gift to me.

I wish that where I am they also may be with me,  
that they may see my glory that you gave me,  
because you loved me before the foundation of the world. Righteous Father, the world also does not know you,  
but I know you, and they know that you sent me.

I made known to them your name and I will make it known,  
that the love with which you loved me  
may be in them and I in them."



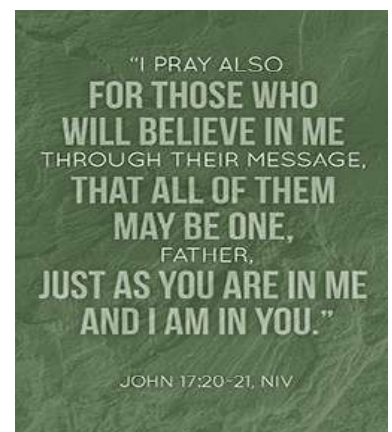

Hall* as we reflect upon, through scripture and sharing, the great Easter theme: "The Great Commissioning."

When I was a child, my mother would get me to do certain chores by first asking, "How much do you love me?" After a while, it didn't take me long to figure out that I was being set up to do something irksome - yet, how can you say "no" to Momma? And even if accompanied by a sigh and a slight eye-roll I would obediently ask in return, "What do you want, Mom?" There was never a question that I was going to turn down a request.

In today's gospel, we come to this final discourse between Jesus and the Eleven disciples. Jesus begins by saying, "Whoever loves me will keep my word." Jesus is not laying out specifics as to what task he is asking his disciples to accomplish. After all, last weekend, we were left with the vague and undetailed commandment, "Love one another." And so, one might wonder, what is this "word" that Jesus asks us to keep? Is it a philosophy? A set of principles by which one should live?

In John's gospel, the word "Word" refers to the vision of God, the dream of God that we might strive live in communion with him and with one another. "In the beginning was the word." It is the vision by which God fashioned this universe in all its beauty and complexity and diversity. But ultimately, the word became flesh - and in Jesus we have the opportunity to actually fall in love with the Father's dream for us and the world. "If you love me . . . you will understand the Father's hope for the world he so lovingly made."

"If you love me." There is the invitation that Jesus extends to us today. Jesus calls us not just to learn a lot of philosophical teachings or moral principles. He calls us to enter into a relationship with him. In that relationship, I can speak my heart to my friend, most especially when the world just becomes too much for me to handle. He wants me to share with him my frustrations when I come upon obstacles that make it nearly impossible to love others. After all, this is what one does with one's closest friend! And he, in turn, will confide in me the Father's desires - but more importantly, give me the hope to believe that those ideals can be achieved and those impossible tasks can be accomplished through the power of him dwelling within us. "The Father and I will come to you and make our dwelling within you." As Saint Paul will say, "I have the strength for everything through him who empowers me."

In the beautiful words of Thomas Merton, we read, "My Lord, God, I have no idea where I am going, and the fact that I think that I am following your will, does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does, in fact, please you. And I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire."

## **Domingo Sexto Del Tiempo De Pascua. Ciclo C. “El Espíritu Santo, Nos Introduce En La Verdad Y En El Amor”.**

Entre los dones pascuales, el mayor es el Espíritu Santo. En este Evangelio Jesús lo anunció, junto con preparar a los discípulos a su partida. En verdad, en el discurso del Señor ambas cosas están ligadas. Era necesario que Jesús muriera, resucitara y fuera al cielo; que su presencia fuera sustraída a los cristianos, para que nos enviara el Espíritu: “...les conviene que yo me vaya, porque si no me voy el espíritu no vendrá a ustedes...”.

Esto nos hace ver la tremenda importancia del Espíritu Santo “runueva la faz de la tierra... haciendo que todas las cosas sean recreadas”. Si esto es verdad, es el gran animador no sólo de la Iglesia sino también de la historia. Porque el Padre es también autor de la creación; ha puesto a Cristo por Señor de la historia, y Cristo actúa en la historia y en la Sociedad por su espíritu.

Lo importante en el cristianismo no es gozar de la presencia física del Señor, “estar con Él” como estaban los discípulos y los judíos de su tiempo. A veces nosotros pensamos que si hubiéramos vivido en esa época, si hubiéramos conocido, visto y escuchado, a Jesús de Nazaret, tendríamos más fe, seríamos mejores cristianos. Pero hubo muchos hombres que en su tiempo lo escucharon, vieron sus Milagros y lo trataron, y no creyeron en Él. La fe y el compromiso con el Señor no es un producto de su presencia, sino de la acción de su Espíritu en nosotros.

Por eso es tan importante que Él subiera al cielo para enviarnos el Espíritu. El “será quien os lo enseñe todo y os vaya recordando todo lo que os he dicho”.

El Espíritu Santo vive en nosotros si somos fieles en creer y en llevar a la práctica las palabras de Jesús: “el que me ama guardará mi palabra y vendremos a Él y haremos morada en él”. Pero ¿qué hace el Espíritu que vive en nosotros? Nos va recordando, a través de la historia, lo que Jesús ha dicho. Nos “enseña todo”; nos enseña a reconocer su acción en el mundo actual, en la Sociedad conflictiva, en las realidades profanas que nos rodean. Nos enseña a descubrir en los acontecimientos personales y colectivos las vetas, los hilos conductores que señalan la presencia del Espíritu; a leer en ellos lo que Dios nos quiere decir, nos quiere exigir, y por dónde nos quiere llevar. El Espíritu Santo es el que “nos lleva a la verdad total”; nos ayuda a no quedarnos en la superficie de lo que sucede y nos sucede, para desentrañar de ahí las exigencias de Cristo en cada caso: “...Él os irá recordando todo lo que os he dicho...”.

Dejémosnos llevar por la obra y las acciones del Espíritu y así continuaremos su obra en este mundo, tratando de vivir sus dones y frutos y podamos exportar la semilla de eternidad en este mundo. Y continuando siempre la obra del Espíritu de Dios. Dejémosnos llenar del Espíritu santo, para que recibamos con mucho amor sus frutos y dones.
