Sacramental Life of our Parish

Baptism for children (*under the age of 7*) is celebrated in English on the first three Sundays at 1 pm; in Spanish on the last Sunday of the month at 1 pm; in Kreyol on the 3rd Saturday at 1 pm. Parents attend a preparation session on the first Monday of the month from 8 to 9:30 pm in the church. Please call the Parish Center (334-0021) to make arrangements to speak to one of our priests or deacons about your child's upcoming baptism.

Celebration of Marriage

Please call the Parish Center (334-0021) at least six months in advance to make arrangements for an interview with one of our parish deacons or priests who will meet with the engaged couple, set the time and date of the wedding, and make arrangements for our parish marriage preparation program.

Rite of Christian Initiation

Adults who have never been baptized are prepared for the reception of the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) through the RCIA process. Other adults may have already been baptized, but are seeking to receive Eucharist and/or Confirmation. Those interested in knowing more about the process of becoming a full member of the Catholic Church are invited to call Sister Ann Horn at 516-334-0021, ext. 353. Parents who have school-aged children who have never been baptized are also invited to speak to Sister Ann about their process of preparation for these sacraments.

Sacraments of School Age Children

Our parish faith formation program prepares children for the celebration of the sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation, and Confirmation. The norm is that children receive a two-year preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist (normally celebrated in the second grade) and a two-year preparation program for Confirmation (normally celebrated in the eighth grade). Our religious education program deepens the experience of faith and religious formation in the years between the celebrations of these sacraments.

Parents who have children older than first grade and are seeking to have them receive the sacraments of Eucharist (First Communion), Reconciliation or Confirmation are asked to call the Religious Education office.

Communion to the Sick and Homebound

Anyone who is not able to attend Mass because of frailty, chronic or temporary illness, or admission to hospice can have Holy Communion brought to them at home on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to make arrangements for a lay minister to bring holy communion.

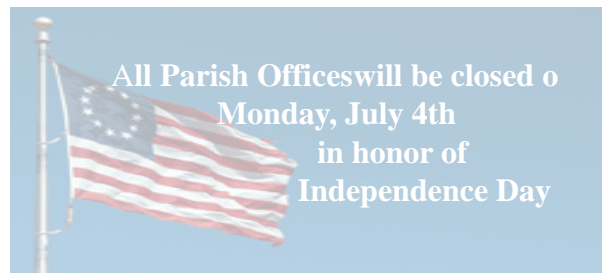

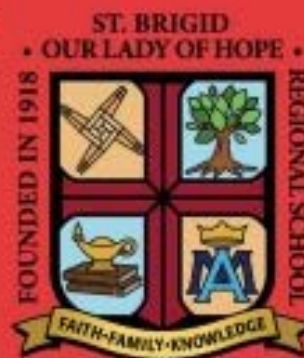

Breaking Open the Word

Reflecting on next Sunday's Gospel before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of liturgy. Here's the Gospel for next Sunday. How does this Gospel touch your life?

July 10th - Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 10:25-37

There was a scholar of the law who stood up to test Jesus and said,

"Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

Jesus said to him, "What is written in the law?

How do you read it?"

He said in reply,

You shall love the Lord, your God,
with all your heart,
with all your being,
with all your strength,
and with all your mind,
and your neighbor as yourself."

He replied to him, "You have answered correctly;
do this and you will live."

But because he wished to justify himself, he said to Jesus,

"And who is my neighbor?"

Jesus replied,

"A man fell victim to robbers

as he went down from Jerusalem to Jericho.

They stripped and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead.

A priest happened to be going down that road,

but when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side.

Likewise a Levite came to the place,

and when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side.

But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him

was moved with compassion at the sight.

He approached the victim,

poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them.

Then he lifted him up on his own animal,

took him to an inn, and cared for him.

The next day he took out two silver coins

and gave them to the innkeeper with the instruction,

"Take care of him.

If you spend more than what I have given you,

I shall repay you on my way back.'

Which of these three, in your opinion,

was neighbor to the robbers' victim?"

He answered, "The one who treated him with mercy."

Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."

Gospel Reflection Questions

- Think of what is needed to inherit eternal life.
- Think of who are your neighbors.
- Think of who are Samaritans in our culture.

Some Questions for Families & Children

- Think of how your friends are your "neighbor".
- Think of what kind of person the Samaritan was.
- Think of friends in your life who you think could be "the Samaritan".

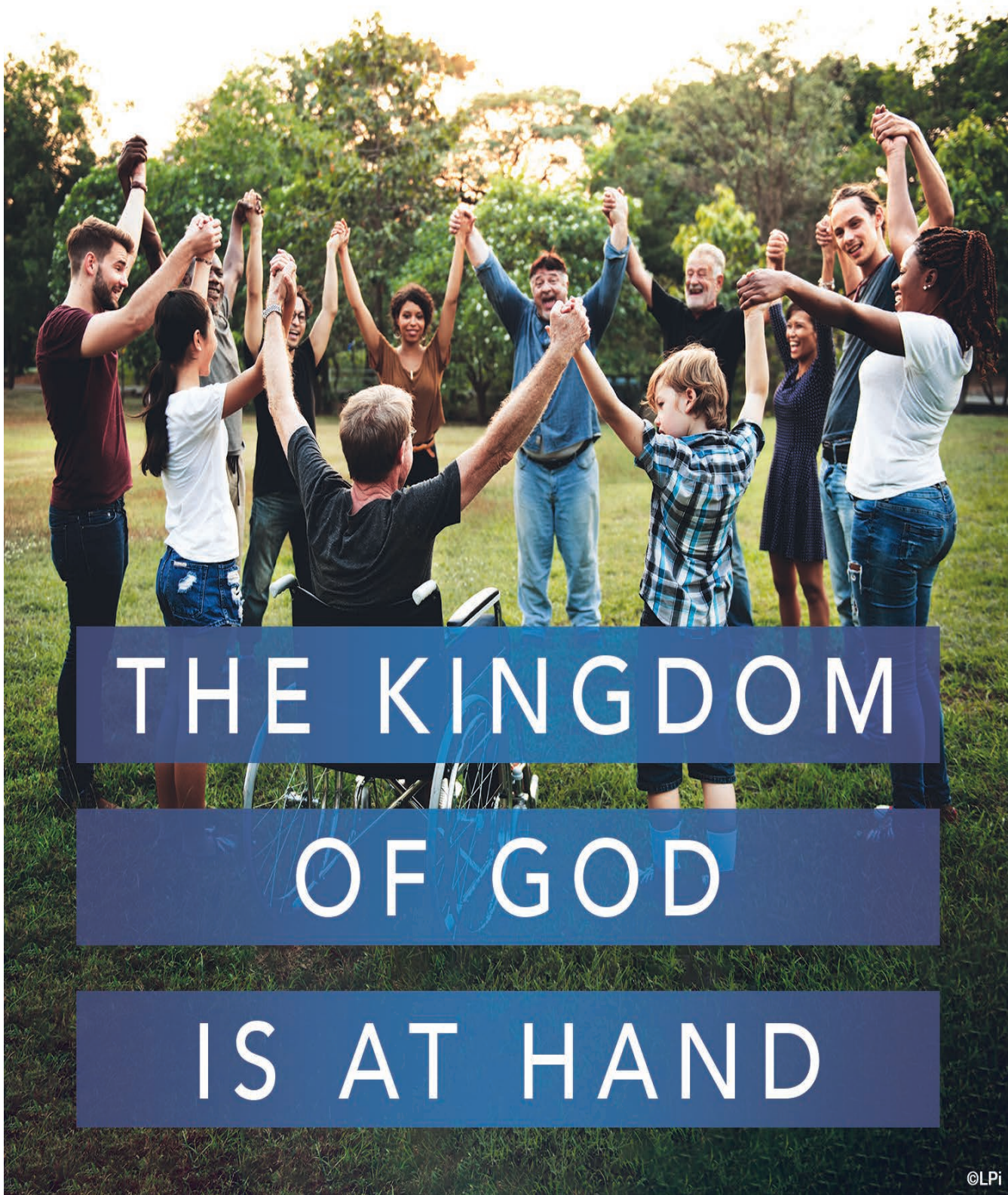

Haitian Commentary, Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time C , 2022

La liturgie de ce 14ème dimanche nous montre Jésus qui envoie les 72 disciples en mission pour que tous les peuples entendent la Bonne Nouvelle. Ils n’ont pas d’abord à annoncer la conversion mais à annoncer la paix.

Le prophète Isaïe ose une parole de paix aux exilés de Babylone revenus dans leur Jérusalem en ruine:” Je dirigerai vers elle(Jérusalem) la Paix comme un fleuve”. Oser une parole de paix, c’est affirmer que le Seigneur est un Dieu de consolation qui prend soin des rescapés.

Pour donner cette Paix, le Seigneur a besoin de ses disciples là où le besoin est pressant. Devant cette tâche si difficile, il les envoie deux par deux pour que l’un puisse épauler l’autre. Il les donne de judicieux conseils: n’emportez rien, ni argent, ni sac, ni sandales. Cela les rend plus disponibles à se mettre en route ensemble. Jésus les demande de demeurer avec ceux qui sont prêts à construire dans la paix. De Jésus nous apprenons qu’il est impossible d’apporter la Paix si l’on ne se fait proche de ceux qui nous accueillent. Il insiste sur le partage du quotidien: le travail, le repas, la durée.
