THE PASTOR'S POST

SEDUCED

Dear Parish Family:

I love this passage from the book of the prophet Jeremiah (20:7-9). It's so honest, so real. "You duped me..." he writes to God! In other translations of this passage, instead of the word duped, the word is translated as deceived, coerced, persuaded, misled, and enticed. Strong words. In one translation I looked at, they translated the word as "seduced". It is a loaded word. To seduce someone is to trick someone into something by making it seem pretty attractive. We often use the words in moments of intimate relations with others.

We know what this is, right? It's sin! From Adam and Eve in the Garden to you and me, we are so easily seduced, no? How many times do we find ourselves led into people, places, and things and we find ourselves asking, "How did this happen?" It often happens because we are seduced. We are led in. We are convinced by our own ego or by some other (person, place, or thing) that this is going to be OK. St. Ignatius warns us, "The evil spirit's behavior can also be compared to a false lover. One who loves falsely uses another for selfish ends, and so people become like objects at one's disposal or like playthings for entertainments or good times" (The Spiritual Exercises, 326).

We are just not used to seeing God in this way. If you just flip through the pages of the first 20 chapters of the book of Jeremiah, you can understand why he's had it. He's frustrated. Everyone is against him. He's falling, being attacked, destroyed and ruined. (And it doesn't get much easier after this for him.) Yet, somehow he remains.

I don't know enough about Jeremiah but I wonder if the answer to those moments in our lives is found in both Jeremiah and in the Gospel. First, take a lesson from this short passage from Jeremiah. Speak from the heart. Jeremiah lets God have it all. You duped me, you seduced me, I let this happen, and I am a laughing-stock, the Word of God is for me derision and so on. He doesn't go easy on the Lord. This is a good lesson for us. It's OK to be honest with God. It's not a sign of a weak faith or doubt. Quite the opposite. It's a sign that we trust enough in the Lord to be real.

In those moments when we feel seduced, we can go in two directions. We can separate ourselves from God and say, "Ah, forget this. I'm done. I'm out of here." Or we can take a lesson from the Gospel. We can surrender. We can take up our cross no matter how we received it and surrender to God's will. This is not easy. We know this. Peter knows this! Listen to him. He's like us. Let's do anything we can to avoid the difficulty and struggle. Jesus won't hear it.

It's a call to us. We never give up or give in. So whether it is sin or suffering, pain or persecution, hurt or hell-like feelings, we keep going. We keep trying. We keep moving. Will we fall - probably? Jesus didn't fall three times with his cross for no reason. It's hard, particularly when we have been seduced by the things of this world.

This is true in good and bad times. So, yes, consider the sins and struggles that we have often imposed on ourselves or allowed to be imposed on ourselves. We have been seduced. Instead of allowing Jesus to walk with us and come through these struggles, we often keep them to ourselves or resist bringing them to the light. The seduction moves even deeper. In these moments, we must do all we can to turn it over to the Lord. To say, "Look I got myself into this mess. I need you, Lord. Jesus, help me!" This is one form of surrender.

Then, think of the times when we find ourselves like Jeremiah. We feel God has led us into this particular moment of our lives. He seduced us into this helping relationship, this ministry, this responsibility, this role, this moment. At different moments and times in my life I find myself serving different people or different situations that bring me to some intense places. In the spirit of Jeremiah, I have found myself saying, "Why did you ever get me into this? Look what you've done." The response is the same. It is one of surrender. To say when we are certain this is God's doing, "OK, Lord, you got me into this. You better be helping through all of this." And then...we have to let him help. (This is a part of surrender I battle!)

So take some time this week and consider the places you have been duped or seduced. Those moments that are about our one weakness and failures, ask the Lord for the grace to surrender to his will. Pray that the seduction we have undergone will bring us to surrender to God's will and separate from those places of darkness. Those moments that we feel are doing God's will but find it overwhelming, talk to the Lord. Pray that we can pick up our cross, surrender to his will and keep walking with his help.

This act of surrender often comes when we are at our breaking point. We are stubborn - well, I am. I don't know about you. It takes a while to get to this point. But when we do, I think we might find ourselves falling even more deeply in love with Jesus. And who knows, might wind up seducing others to follow Him more closely with great promises for happiness in this life and we pray, in the life to come!

Please, if you can, say a prayer for me. I promise the same.

EL POSTO DEL PARROCO

SEDUCED

Querida familia parroquial:

Me encanta este pasaje del libro del profeta Jeremías (20:7-9). Es tan honesto, tan real. "Me has engañado...", escribe a Dios. En otras traducciones de este pasaje, en lugar de la palabra embaucado, la palabra se traduce como engañado, coaccionado, persuadido, extraviado y seducido. Palabras fuertes. En una traducción que busqué, tradujeron la palabra como "seducido". Es una palabra cargada. Seducir a alguien es engañarle para que haga algo haciéndole parecer atractivo. A menudo utilizamos estas palabras en momentos de relaciones íntimas con otras personas.

Sabemos lo que es, ¿verdad? Es el pecado. Desde Adán y Eva en el Jardín hasta usted y yo, somos tan fácilmente seducidos, ¿no? Cuántas veces nos encontramos llevados hacia personas, lugares y cosas y nos encontramos preguntándonos: "¿Cómo sucedió esto?". A menudo sucede porque somos seducidos. Nos dejamos llevar. Estamos convencidos por nuestro propio ego o por algún otro (persona, lugar o cosa) de que esto va a estar bien. San Ignacio nos advierte: "El comportamiento del espíritu maligno también puede compararse al de un falso amante. El que ama falsamente usa a otro para fines egoístas, y así las personas se vuelven como objetos a disposición de uno o como juguetes para entretenerse o pasar buenos ratos" (Los Ejercicios Espirituales, 326). Se me ocurren tantas veces en mi propia vida en las que lo he sentido. Me he dejado seducir. Esto será bueno, aunque sé que no lo es... rápidamente seducido lejos de mi relación con Jesús hacia algún otro. ¿Tal vez usted puede relacionar?

No estamos acostumbrados a ver a Dios de esta manera. Si hojeas las páginas de los primeros 20 capítulos del libro de Jeremías, entenderás por qué está hartado. Está frustrado. Todo el mundo está en su contra. Está cayendo, siendo atacado, destruido y arruinado. (Y después de esto las cosas no se ponen mucho más fáciles para él.) Sin embargo, de alguna manera permanece.

No sé lo suficiente sobre Jeremías, pero me pregunto si la respuesta a esos momentos de nuestras vidas se encuentra tanto en Jeremías como en el Evangelio. En primer lugar, saca una lección de este breve pasaje de Jeremías. Habla desde el corazón. Jeremías deja que Dios lo tenga todo. Tú engañaste, tú sedujiste, yo dejé que esto sucediera, yo soy el hazmerreír, la Palabra de Dios es para mí escarnio y así sucesivamente. No se lo pone fácil al Señor. Esta es una buena lección para nosotros. Está bien ser sincero con Dios. No es señal de una fe débil o de duda. Todo lo contrario. Es señal de que confiamos lo suficiente en el Señor como para ser sinceros.

En esos momentos en que nos sentimos seducidos, podemos ir en dos direcciones. Podemos separarnos de Dios y decir: "Ah, olvídate de esto. He terminado. Me largo de aquí". O podemos tomar una lección del Evangelio. Podemos rendirnos. Podemos tomar nuestra cruz, no

importa cómo la hayamos recibido, y rendirnos a la voluntad de Dios. Esto no es fácil. Nosotros lo sabemos. Pedro lo sabe. Escuchadle. Él es como nosotros. Hagamos todo lo posible para evitar la dificultad y la lucha. Jesús no lo escuchará.

Es una llamada para nosotros. Nunca nos rendimos ni nos damos por vencidos. Así que ya sea pecado o sufrimiento, dolor o persecución, heridas o sentimientos infernales, seguimos adelante. Seguimos intentándolo. Seguimos avanzando. ¿Caeremos - probablemente? Jesús no cayó tres veces con su cruz sin razón. Es duro, sobre todo cuando hemos sido seducidos por las cosas de este mundo.

Esto es cierto tanto en los buenos como en los malos tiempos. Así que, sí, considera los pecados y las luchas que a menudo nos hemos impuesto o hemos permitido que nos impongan. Hemos sido seducidos. En lugar de permitir que Jesús camine con nosotros y atraviese estas luchas, a menudo las guardamos para nosotros mismos o nos resistimos a sacarlas a la luz. La seducción se hace aún más profunda. En estos momentos, debemos hacer todo lo posible para entregárselo al Señor. Decir: "Mira, yo me he metido en este lío. Te necesito, Señor. Jesús, ayúdame". Esta es una forma de rendición.

Luego, pensemos en los momentos en que nos encontramos como Jeremías. Sentimos que Dios nos ha conducido a este momento particular de nuestras vidas. Nos ha seducido a esta relación de ayuda, a este ministerio, a esta responsabilidad, a este papel, a este momento. En diferentes momentos de mi vida me encuentro sirviendo a diferentes personas o en diferentes situaciones que me llevan a lugares intensos. Me he encontrado diciendo, en el espíritu de Jeremías, "¿Por qué me metiste en esto? Mira lo que has hecho". La respuesta es la misma. Es una de rendición. Decir cuando estamos seguros de que esto es obra de Dios: "Está bien, Señor, tú me metiste en esto. Será mejor que me ayudes en todo esto". Y entonces... tenemos que dejar que nos ayude. (¡Esta es una parte de la rendición contra la que lucho!) Este acto de rendición suele producirse cuando estamos en nuestro punto de ruptura. Somos testarudos, bueno, yo lo soy. No sé tú. Llegar a este punto lleva tiempo. Pero cuando lo hacemos, creo que podemos encontrarnos aún más profundamente enamorados de Jesús. Y, quién sabe, quizá acabemos seduciendo a otros para que le sigan más de cerca con grandes promesas de felicidad en esta vida y, rezamos, ¡en la vida venidera!

Por favor, si puedes, reza una oración por mí. Prometo lo mismo.

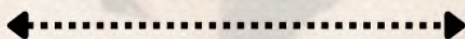

St. Lorenzo Ruiz

The first Filipino Saint, known to be the Patron Saint of the Filipino youth, overseas workers, and altar servers.

EARLY YEARS

- St. Lorenzo Ruiz was born on November 28, 1594 in Binondo, Manila, Philippines
- He had a Chinese father and a Filipino mother, and his family shaped him into becoming a God-fearing person.
- His childhood was filled with prayers, religious rituals and praise and worship.
- He was educated at the Convent of Santo Domingo led by Dominican Friars.
- He became an altar boy and discovered that the Church is his personal sanctuary.

ADULTHOOD

- He married a Filipina named Rosario and they had three children.
- It was not an easy journey for them as a family living a simple life but they held onto their faith amidst the difficult reality of life.
- In 1636, his life was challenged by being accused of murdering a Spaniard, a crime he did not commit.
- He escaped and boarded a ship to Japan.

ROAD TO MARTYRDOM

- Japan was a country where they persecuted faithful and devout Christians, believers were oppressed and Lorenzo started his journey to Martyrdom.
- Lorenzo and his companions were held captives for two years by the Japanese officials and were ordered to recant their faith.
- Those who remained faithful were tortured and hanged upside down.
- Lorenzo was one of those people whose faith remained unbroken.
- His response to the pain and torture was deepened devotion and fervent prayers "I am a Catholic and wholeheartedly do accept death for God. Had I a thousand lives, all these to Him shall I offer."

ROAD TO SAINTHOOD

- Lorenzo's martyrdom paved triumphant affirmation and it continues to thrive in the hearts of the faithful.
- In the Philippines, Lorenzo's spirit is highly honored because he truly embodies the strength, resilience, and faithfulness which Filipinos hold onto in times of difficulties.
- His great influence extends beyond the boundaries of his homeland and has reached many Christians around the globe.
- On February 18, 1981, Lorenzo was beatified by Pope John Paul II. The beatification ceremony was held in the Philippines making it the first beatification ceremony ever held outside the Vatican.
- His canonization took place at the Vatican on October 18, 1987. This was based on a miracle that took place in 1983, when Cecilia Alegria Policarpio, a two-year old girl suffering from in-born brain atrophy (hydrocephalus) was cured after her family and supporters prayed to Lorenzo for his intercession.
