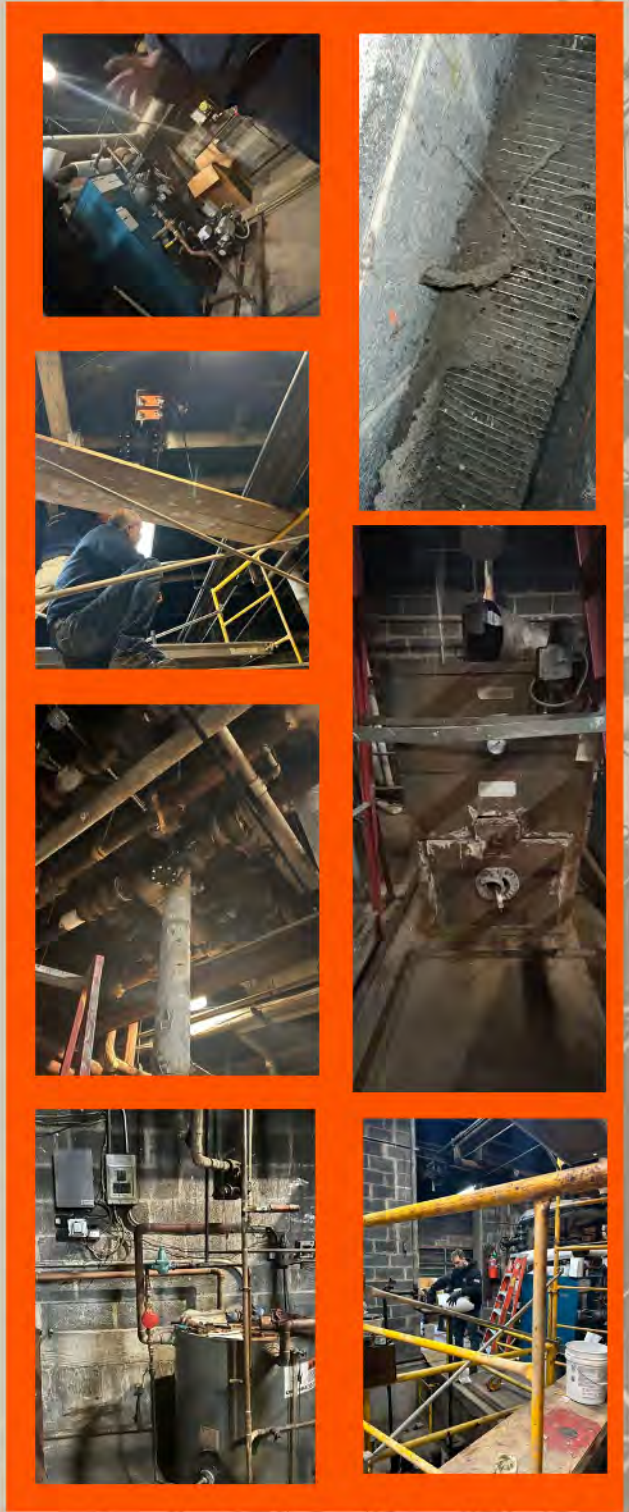

# LIFE@ST. BRIGID

I'll try every now and then, going forward, to give you some updates about some of the challenges in our buildings. Over the past few weeks, we have entered into a process of making our school building more efficient. Essentially, for the last years, the boilers had one temperature option - on or off. With that they were running constantly but not necessarily heating the building. Over the past four years we have spent \$256,626 for oil for the school building ALONE. In addition, we have incurred maintenance expenses of \$76,145 (this does not include the installation of two new boilers in that time). We just cannot go on like this.

We are re-installing valves, re-insulated the boiler piping, put in a water regulator, installed new thermostats that are functional, and cleaned out all of the radiators. This is an investment but one that will save us thousands next winter. We will need to install a new boiler this summer and are working the secure bids for this project.

Caring for the buildings is at times a thankless job but an essential one. These buildings have been entrusted to us by previous generations allowing us to minister to so many, and it is our responsibility to restore them for the future generations to come.
