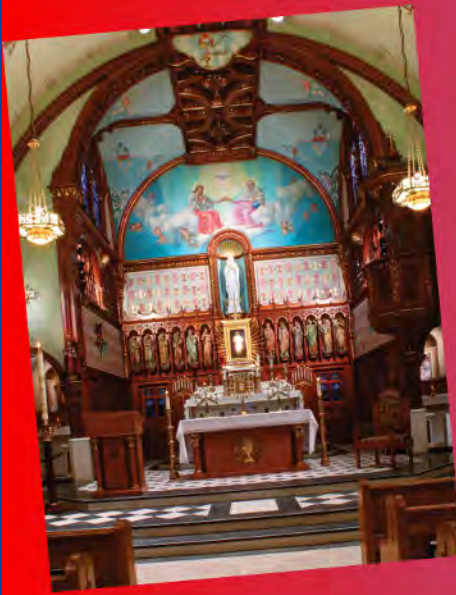

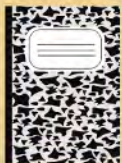

### **First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8**

Moses urged the Israelites to be faithful to the commands of the Lord. They were not to change them in any way but to follow them wisely.

- What are the "Commands of the Lord?"
- How many can you name?

### **Second Reading: James 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27**

In order for God's word to take root, believers must do more than merely listen to it. They must act upon it.

- In what ways can we act upon it?
- How does the church act upon it?

### **Gospel: Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23**

Jesus said that nothing coming from outside can make a person impure. Rather, it is the evil coming from within that constitutes impurity.

- How can we evaluate our commitment to our community?
- How do we keep the balance between God and our neighbors in our lives of service.
