EL POST DEL PARROCO

¡TENEMOS VACANTES!

Querida Familia Parroquial:

Escribo esto el miércoles después de dare la bienvenida a los estudiantes el primer día de clases de nuestra increíble escuela católica. Es un inicio - un nuevo comienzo para cada uno de ellos. Para algunos, es la primera vez que se unen a nuestra increíble comunidad. Para otros, es un nuevo curso o una nueva parte del colegio. En cualquier caso, la presencia de Cristo habita en lo más profundo y alrededor de nuestros jóvenes.

Ayer, (Martes) nos reunimos con profesores de toda la diócesis de Rockville Centre para Inaugurar la jornada de este año escolar en oración y reflexión para profesores de escuelas católicas de toda la diócesis. Con el espíritu del Renacimiento Eucarístico, hubo oportunidades para la oración y la reflexión sobre el don de la Eucaristía. Para algunos, quizás una nueva apertura al encuentro con el Cuerpo de Cristo en el don de la Eucaristía.

El Día del Trabajo, tuve el privilegio de compartir con miembros de nuestra comunidad Hispana para la celebración diocesana anual en el Seminario de la Inmaculada Concepción en Huntington. Fue una oportunidad para encontrar a Cristo en el regalo de la Eucaristía en la Misa y la fe vibrante de tantos. Otra apertura a las muchas maneras en que Dios me llama a crecer y a ser desafiada en mi fe. (También ayudé a hacer pupusas - ¡no estoy seguro de que fuera una buena apertura para la gente que se las comió :)!)

Durante el fin de semana, invité a una cena familiar en un restaurante a una persona que conozco y a la que le cuesta mucho conocer gente nueva. La persona vino... ¡y se lo pasó muy bien! Cada vez que cogían el teléfono, mi madre daba un golpecito en la mesa y decía: "¡Eh... es hora de compartir conmigo, no con tu teléfono!". Sonreían... y colgaban el teléfono. (¡Incluso llamó desde el otro lado de la mesa para hacer sonreír a la persona!) Una apertura para ver las muchas maneras en que esta persona es amada y cuidada en medio de sus propias luchas (¡y las nuestras, seguro!).

"¡Ephphatha!" - es decir, "¡Ábrete!" - dice Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy. Es tiempo de apertura.



Pronunciamos estas palabras en el *Rito del Bautismo* rezando para que los recién bautizados escuchen y pronuncien siempre las palabras de Cristo en sus vidas. Es tan necesario ahora en mi vida y en la tuya como lo fue cuando fuimos bautizados. Es una llamada a vivir como Cristo y a una renovada apertura a todo lo que Jesús nos pide.

Septiembre es tradicionalmente un tiempo de nuevos comienzos, ya que pasamos del verano al principio del otoño. Estos nuevos comienzos exigen una apertura a todo lo que Dios tiene reservado para nosotros y pueden incluso requerir un cierre a las cosas que NOSOTROS pensamos que Dios tiene reservado para nosotros.

Así que buenas noticias.... Tenemos APERTURAS para aquellos que desean ser abiertos, que desean responder al mandato de Jesús en el Evangelio. Consideremos:

- tiempo para un nuevo ministerio y misión aquí en Santa Brígida. Para algunos, septiembre es un tiempo de nuevos comienzos después de la jubilación. ¡Tú no has terminado! Hay mucho que dar (y recibir) aquí en Santa Brígida.
- aberturas para la oración y la reflexión. Espero que, como parroquia, podamos examinar juntos nuestro aprendizaje de la oración, en particular la Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento y algunas nuevas clases de formación en la fe para adultos. A nivel personal, tal vez un tiempo para considerar una nueva apertura para la oración - un nuevo ritmo, método, tiempo, lugar, etc.
- las muchas y diversas experiencias de oración y cultura que ofrece nuestra comunidad. Esta podría ser la apertura que necesitas para una vida espiritual más profunda.
- abrirse en amistad a través de ministerios como Martha y Compañía, Ensayo de Bodas, Ministerio, Formación de Fe Familiar, nuestros increíbles coros y más.

Juntos, comprometámonos a estar abiertos a todo lo que Dios tiene reservado para nosotros.

Por favor, rezad por mí, ¡os prometo lo mismo!

THE PASTOR'S POST

WE HAVE OPENINGS!!!

Dear Parish Family:

I am writing this on Wednesday after leaving the first day of school for many of the students at our incredible Catholic school. It is an opening - a new beginning for each of them. For some, they are joining our amazing community for the first time. For others, it's a new grade or new part of the school. Either way, the presence of Christ dwells deep within and surrounds our young people.

Yesterday, we gathered with teachers throughout the Diocese of Rockville Centre for the Opening Day of Prayer and Reflection for Catholic school teachers throughout the diocese. Coming with a spirit of the Eucharistic Revival, there were opportunities for prayer and reflection about the gift of the Eucharist. For some, perhaps a new opening to encounter the Body of Christ in the gift of the Eucharist.

On Labor Day, I had the privilege to join with many members of our Spanish community for an annual diocesan celebration at the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington. An opening to encounter Christ in the gift of the Eucharist at Mass and the vibrant faith of so many. Another opening to the many ways God is calling me to grow and to be challenged in my faith. (I also helped to make pupusas - not sure that was a good opening for the people who ate them :!)

Over the weekend, I invited someone I know who struggles greatly with meeting new people to a family dinner in a restaurant. The person came...and actually had a good time! Whenever they reached for their phone, my mom would tap on the table and say, "Hey...it's focus time with me not your phone!" They smiled...and put down the phone. (She even called from across the table to make the person smile!) An opening to see the many ways this person is loved and cared for in the midst of their own struggles (and ours, for sure!).

"Ephphatha!"— that is, "Be opened! - Jesus says in



the Gospel today. It is a time for openings.

We speak these words in the *Rite of Baptism* praying that the newly baptized will always hear and speak the words of Christ in their lives. It is as necessary now in my life and yours as it was when we were baptized. It is a call to Christ-like living and a renewed openness to all that Jesus is asking of us.

September is traditionally a time of new beginnings as we move from summer to the beginning of Fall. These new beginnings call for an openness to all that God has in store for us and may even require a closing to the things WE think God has in store for us!

So good news....we have OPENINGS for those who desire to be opened, who desire to respond to Jesus' command in the Gospel. Consider:

- time for a new ministry and mission here at St. Brigid's. For some, September is a time of new beginnings after retirement. You're not done! So much to give (and to receive) here at St. Brigid's.
- openings for prayer and reflection. I hope, as a parish, we can look together at our prayer learning, particularly Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and some new adult faith formation classes. On a personal level, perhaps a time to consider a new opening for prayer - a new rhythm, method, time, place, etc.
- The many diverse experiences of prayer and culture that our community offers. This might be the opening you need for a deeper spiritual life.
- Opening yourself up in friendship through ministries like Martha and Company, Wedding Rehearsal, Ministry, Family Faith Formation, our incredible choirs and more.

Together, let us commit to being open to all that God has in store for us!

Please pray for me - I promise the same!

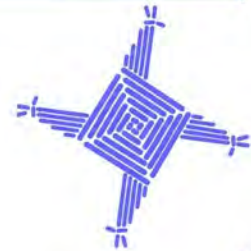
