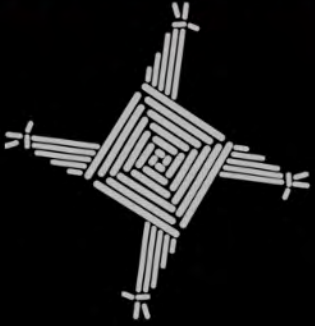

LOVE WITHOUT LIMITS.

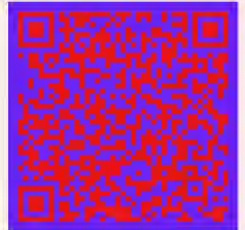
Here's how it works!

3. Then read the reflection, suggestion for action, and prayer and make it the focus of your day throughout Lent and Easter.

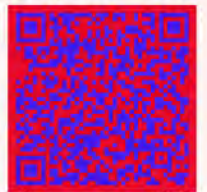

Liturgy and Lent

How we pray changes a bit during Lent so we may better enter more deeply into this season of conversion and transformation.

- The *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* reminds us, "In Lent the playing of the organ and musical instruments is allowed only in order to support the singing. Exceptions, however, are Laetare Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent), Solemnities, and Feasts." Therefore, you may hear a little less of the organ and piano and other instruments throughout this season.
- The bells on the Church will not ring again until Easter Sunday.
- We will have silence during the time of the Preparation of the Altar and the Presentation of the Gifts, except on the 4th Sunday of Lent.
- The Gloria (Glory to God) is not said or sung during Lent, except on the Solemnity of St. Joseph (celebrated this year on Thursday, March 19th and on the Feast of the Annunciation on Wednesday, March 25th. We will sing the Gloria again at the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and then again at the Easter Vigil.
- The Alleluia is omitted from all hymns and as the Gospel Acclamation during Masses. We will chant a different verse during the season of Lent until the Easter Vigil.
- We will use the Apostles' Creed instead of the Nicene Creed. The Roman Missal (#19) clearly encourages the use of the Apostles' Creed during the seasons of Lent and Easter. The text can also be found in *Unidos en Cristo/United in Christ* and in the *Sanctus* and *Sunday Word* books.

La forma de rezar cambia un poco durante la Cuaresma para que podamos entrar más profundamente en este tiempo de conversión y transformación.

- *La Instrucción General del Misal Romano* nos recuerda: "En Cuaresma se permite tocar el órgano y los instrumentos musicales sólo para apoyar el canto. Las excepciones, sin embargo, son el Domingo Laetare (Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma), las Solemnidades y las Fiestas". Por lo tanto, es posible que oigáis un poco menos el órgano y el piano y otros instrumentos a lo largo de este tiempo.
- Las campanas de la Iglesia no volverán a sonar hasta el Domingo de Resurrección.
- Tendremos silencio durante el tiempo de la Preparación del Altar y la Presentación de las Ofrendas, excepto el 4º Domingo de Cuaresma.
- El Gloria (Gloria a Dios) no se dice ni se canta durante la Cuaresma, excepto en la Solemnidad de San José (que este año se celebra el jueves 19 de marzo) y la Solemnidad de la Anuncio (se celebra el miércoles 25 de marzo.) . Volveremos a cantar el Gloria en la Misa vespertina de la Cena del Señor y después en la Vigilia Pascual.
- El Aleluya se omite en todos los himnos y como Aclamación del Evangelio durante las Misas. Cantaremos un versículo diferente durante el tiempo de Cuaresma hasta la Vigilia Pascual.
- Usaremos el Credo de los Apóstoles en lugar del Credo Niceno.

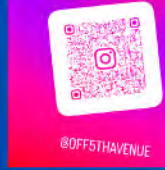

Looking Ahead...*Second Sunday of Lent*

Pray with next Sunday's readings and consider these questions. You can access the readings at www.usccb.org or by making use of the *Sunday's Word* or *Sanctus* books.

First Reading: Genesis 12:1-4A

Abram was commanded by the Lord to leave his home and go to a new land. There the Lord God would make of him a great nation, and all would be blessed because of him.

- What was Abraham's response to God's request?
- What are some blessings you have received?

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 1:8b-10

God saves all people and calls them to a holy life, not because of their own merit but because of the grace held out in Christ. Christ "destroyed death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel."

- How did Timothy come to faith?
- How can we show power, love and discipline?

Gospel: Matthew 17:1-9

Jesus went up to a high mountain. With Moses and Elijah at his side, he was transfigured before the eyes of his disciples Peter, James, and John. A voice from the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."

- What does it mean that Jesus was "transfigured?"
- How did the disciples react to hearing God's voice?
