# EL POST DEL PARROCO

## LAS HERIDAS DEL PAPA

Querida familiar parroquial:

¡Feliz Pascua! Hoy concluimos la octava de Pascua... y continuamos nuestro camino a lo largo de los 50 días de Pascua. Este es un tiempo de gran alegría para nosotros como católicos, una alegría que rogamos nos impulse a superar los momentos difíciles y desafiantes de nuestra época, tal como ocurre en el Evangelio de hoy.

Muchos predicadores, eruditos, Padres y Madres de la Iglesia primitiva y comentaristas señalan que Jesús regresó herido. Hay mucho en lo que podemos reflexionar y orar al respecto, sobre todo cuando tenemos presentes nuestras propias luchas y dolores. Espero que esas heridas se conviertan en puntos de entrada para nosotros. Jesús resucitado y glorificado regresa al Cenáculo herido. Las heridas permanecen. ¡Transformadas, sí! Desaparecidas, no. Quizás sea un recordatorio para ti y para mí de que, cuando sentimos que nuestras heridas se han afianzado o que no ha habido la sanación o la restauración que deseábamos, debemos buscar más. La existencia de las heridas no significa que la transformación no se esté produciendo.

Pienso en estos días en el papa Francisco y en el papa León. El papa Francisco falleció el lunes después de Pascua del año pasado (una fecha diferente) y, desde entonces, la Iglesia y el mundo han ido conociendo al papa León XIV. Al igual que el papa Francisco, el papa León habla con claridad. El habla con claridad en el lenguaje del Evangelio. ¿Puedo compartir dos áreas de dolor que el papa León ha estado abordando últimamente?

En primer lugar, el papa León ha hecho un llamado a la paz al mundo, sin temor a expresar con claridad las palabras del Evangelio. Anoche dijo: «Hoy, como todos sabemos, también ha habido esta amenaza contra todo el pueblo de Irán. ¡Y esto es verdaderamente inaceptable! Sin duda, aquí hay cuestiones de derecho internacional, pero, más aún, se trata de una cuestión moral que atañe al bien del pueblo en su conjunto, en su totalidad... Recordemos, especialmente, a los inocentes: los niños, los ancianos, los enfermos, tantas personas que ya se han convertido, o se convertirán, en víctimas de esta guerra continua; y recordemos a todos que los ataques contra la infraestructura civil van en contra del derecho internacional, y que también son un signo del odio, la división y la destrucción de los que es capaz el ser



humano». El papa León nos llama a la oración y a la acción. En nuestra búsqueda de la sacralidad de toda vida humana, en nuestra búsqueda de la paz, debemos alzar la voz y expresarnos para intentar lograr un cambio.

Que esta sea nuestra oración esta semana: sí, por el fin de la guerra, pero sobre todo por nuestra acción y nuestro compromiso.

En segundo lugar, quiero hablarles de la Red Mundial de Oración del Papa (<https://www.popesprayer.va/es/rezaconelpapa/>; Código QR en esta página). Es una herramienta muy valiosa que me ha ayudado en mi oración durante estos años, con diferentes oraciones y sugerencias. Además, cada mes el Papa propone una intención de oración para que todos recemos. Por lo general, hay un video y algunas sugerencias para profundizar en la oración. Este mes, la intención de oración es por los sacerdotes en crisis. Vaya, en medio de todo lo que está sucediendo en nuestro mundo, el Papa es consciente de las «luchas y heridas» de los sacerdotes y nos llama a la oración.



Siempre digo, sobre todo cuando los jóvenes me preguntan sobre el sacerdocio, que ser sacerdote es una vida maravillosa, pero no es fácil. Al igual que todas y cada una de las personas, los sacerdotes se enfrentan a las dificultades de la vida cotidiana. Estoy seguro, además, de que algunas de sus tentaciones y luchas son también las mías. Y hemos visto a sacerdotes luchar e incluso tomarse un tiempo libre, incluso en nuestra propia parroquia. Y en nuestra historia como Iglesia local y global, conocemos la herida del abuso, el abuso de poder, el encubrimiento y el escándalo.

El papa León tiene razón en esto. Así que, este mes, ¿podrías dedicar un momento a rezar por un sacerdote, ya sea aquí en Santa Brígida o en otro lugar, para que Dios le conceda la fuerza, el consuelo y la paz que necesita? Sin duda, hoy no sería sacerdote si no fuera por las oraciones de las personas que Dios ha puesto en mi vida.

Así que esta semana, dejemos que las palabras y las oraciones del Papa nos guíen hacia algunos de esos lugares de dolor y nos ayuden a atravesarlos. Con la certeza de que la resurrección lo cambia todo, sabemos que superaremos estos momentos de dolor, aunque quede una cicatriz.

Por favor, reza por mí. Yo haré lo mismo. *Faithbudin*

# THE PASTOR'S POST

## THE POPE'S WOUNDS

Dear Parish Family

Happy Easter! We conclude the Easter octave today...and continue on our journey through the great 50 days of Easter. This is a time of great joy for us as Catholics, a joy we pray moves us through the difficult and challenging moments of our times, in the same way it does in the Gospel today.

Many preachers, scholars, Fathers and Mothers of the early Church, and commentators remark about Jesus returning wounded. There is much for us to pray with there, particularly as we come mindful of our own struggles and pains. Those wounds become entry points for us, I hope. The resurrected and glorified Jesus returns to the Upper Room wounded. The wounds remain. Transformed, yes! Disappeared, no. Maybe a reminder for you and for me when we feel our wounds have taken hold or that there has not been the healing or restoration we have wanted, we search more. The existence of wounds does not mean that transformation is not taking hold.

I think in these days of Pope Francis and Pope Leo. Pope Francis died on the Monday after Easter last year (a different date) and since that time the Church and the world has been coming to know Pope Leo XIV. It is interesting for those whose first language is English to hear the Holy Father speak in a language most clear to us. Like Pope Francis, Pope Leo is speaking clearly. I hope you and I are listening. He is not only speaking clearly in English, he is speaking clearly in the language of the Gospel. Can I share two areas of woundedness Pope Leo has been addressing lately?



First, Pope Leo has called the world to peace, unafraid to speak the words of the Gospel clearly. Last night, he said, "Today, as we all know, there has also been this threat against the entire people of Iran. And this is truly unacceptable! There are certainly issues of international law here, but even more, it is a moral question concerning the good of the people as a whole, in its entirety...Let's remember, especially, the innocent: children, the elderly, the sick, so many people who have already become, or will become, victims of this continued warfare—and to remind all that attacks on civilian

infrastructure are against international law, and that they are also a sign of the hatred, division, and destruction that the human being is capable of." Pope Leo calls us to prayer and to action. In our pursuit for the sacredness of all human life, in our pursuit for peace, we must speak up and out trying to bring about change.

Let this be our prayer this week - yes for an end to war but even more so for our action and engagement.

Second, I want to share with you about the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network

(<https://www.popesprayer.va/>; QR



Code on this page too!). It is a powerful tool that has helped my prayer in these years with different prayers and suggestions. In addition, each month the Pope offers a prayer intention for each of us to pray. There is usually a video and some suggestions for further prayer. This month, the prayer intention is for priests in crisis. Wow, in the midst of all that is happening in our world, the pope is aware of the "struggles and wounds" of priests and is calling us to prayer.

I always say, especially when asked by young people about priesthood, that to be a priest is an awesome life - but it is not an easy one. Like each and every person, priests struggle with the "everyday" moments of life. I'm sure, too, that some of your temptations and struggles are mine as well. And we have seen priests struggle and even take leave, even from our own parish. And in our history as a local and global church, we know the wound of abuse, the abuse of power, cover up and scandal.

Pope Leo is on to something here. So this month, can you take time to pray for a priest, here at St. Brigid's or in another place, that God will bring them the strength, consolation and peace they need? I would definitely not be a priest today if it were not for the prayers of the people God has put in my life.

So this week, let the words and the prayers of the Pope lead us to and through some of those places of woundedness. Confident that the resurrection changes all things, we know we can come through these moments of pain, even if a scar remains.

Please pray for me. I promise the same.

# COMMUNION VESSELS NEEDED

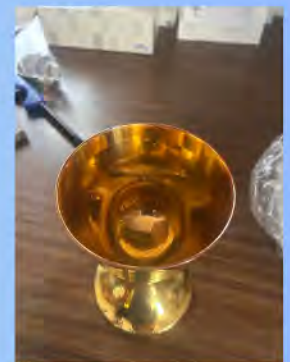
We are in need of some restoration help and in need of some new vessels for our celebration of Mass and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

# MISSION Reflections

2026



*During Lent 2026, Lentn Mission were offered in various langauges about “Love Without Limits” During the next few weeks we’ll share a “re-cap” from each mission which we pray will inspire and challenge us!*

During the forty days of Lent in the year 2026, the Parish of Saint Brigid, had the privilege of discovering, deepening, reflecting, and meditating on the document written by pope Leo XIV entitled: “Dilexi Te – Love without limits”

It was a great opportunity for the people of God to discover the richness of its contents, which can help them grow in their faith, love the church more deeply, and become more engaged to its life.

Within the Haitian community, we had three-day retreat. We reflected on the following themes on March 5, 6, and 7, 2026:

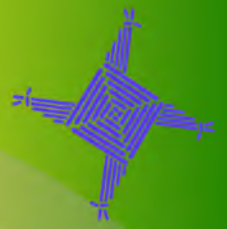
