Grounded in Faith

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

- Informed by our Catholic faith, daily activities that focus on kindness and love are incorporated throughout the curriculum that form future saints (We hope!)
- Young children learn best through hands-on, meaningful play experiences that promote spiritual, social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development.
- Children learn to share, cooperate, and problem solve together.
- Movement and outdoor play in our two playgrounds, gym, and movement room are integral in supporting gross motor development
- Art, music, and dramatic play are central to the curriculum.
- At age appropriate levels, concepts like letters, numbers, letter sound recognition, and science are experienced through games, storytelling, role play and hands on materials.
- Classes are led by a teacher and teacher assistant.

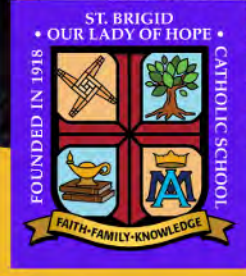

Family Faith Formation @ St. Brigid's!



We are blessed at St. Brigid's to have a formation program for young people that is committed to bringing families together in the faith! Since 2024, St. Brigid's has offered this model. It is different and calls on families to work together in the faith journey!

Here is how our Family Faith Formation model works for students in **Grades 1-6** (BREAD):

- There are **no weekly classes**...so children are not sitting in another classroom after a long day of school.
- Parents and children come together **ONLY once a month here at St. Brigid's**. So you're only here one week a month for “class”. This saves you travel and worries with transportation. At these meeting we try to form parents and children - sometimes together and sometimes separately. We have a great crew of catechists who pull all of this together.
- Parents and children **work together at home during the month**. This is a challenge at times...but we will do our best to support you. We have a good resource book for parents.
- **Families come to Mass together** throughout the year and complete reflections and other activities in their journal.

This model is different, for sure! Yet we are working to form not only our young people but also inviting the entire family on the journey.

This spring and summer, we hope to paint 4-5 additional classrooms in our school. This painting can actually begin in the Spring. THE FLOOR + EL SUELO

I promised I would give you an update about the floor in the Church and also want to let you know about some roof work we have had to have completed.

Over the past week, we have been working to create openings below the Church so engineers are able to examine and construct a report on this area. It has not been easy work. Parts of the foundation and related areas of the church building were built and covered with no way to enter them. So this has been our first piece of work....and it has been quite a job. HVAC duct work had been installed under there in the last renovation. That was temporarily removed so this excavation work could begin.

Durante la última semana, hemos estado trabajando para crear aberturas debajo de la iglesia, de modo que los ingenieros puedan examinar esta zona y elaborar un informe al respecto. No ha sido una tarea fácil. Partes de los cimientos y áreas relacionadas del edificio de la iglesia se construyeron y cubrieron sin dejar ninguna forma de acceder a ellas. Así que esta ha sido nuestra primera tarea... y ha sido un trabajo considerable. En la última renovación se instalaron conductos de climatización debajo de esa zona. Estos se retiraron temporalmente para poder comenzar los trabajos de excavación.

As this work is complete, we will have engineers come into the examine the full gravity of the problem. We have issues with the floor in both the north and south transpets and likely throughout the entire Church. For now, one step a time!

Una vez finalizados estos trabajos, llamaremos a unos ingenieros para que evalúen la gravedad real del problema. Tenemos problemas con el piso tanto en los transeptos norte y sur como, probablemente, en toda la iglesia. ¡Por ahora, vamos paso a paso!

MISSION Reflections

2026



During Lent 2026, Lenten Missions were offered in various languages about “Love Without Limits” During the next few weeks we’ll share a “re-cap” from each mission which we pray will inspire and challenge us!

As part of our Lenten journey, the Filipino community went through an inspiring talk on “Dilexi Te” on March 18th. It was such a blessing to have the presence of Deacon Ronald Lacsas from St. Martin of Tours in Bethpage as our guest speaker, and Deacon Nilo De Leon from Our Lady of Lourdes in West Islip, who also chimed in with meaningful ideas during the session’s Q & A portion.

Deacon Ronald touched on several key points which includes but not limited to Jesus’ humble birth in a manger, the Holy Family’s lowly livelihood, Jesus’ sacrificial suffering and a painful death. Jesus’ poverty life shows the bond and relationship to the suffering and cry of the poor, that we are called to share Christ’s journey of carrying the burden of the cross. We are reminded of our moral obligation to do alms giving and to empathize the needy, the abandoned, the marginalized, the destitute and those impoverished members of our society.

We also heard to equip ourselves with prayer so we can perform our humanely task with zeal and compassion just like the way Christ has displayed his unconditional love for the poor. Prayer is a significant tool in our respective life. Our intensive prayer in times of difficulties should be the same level of prayer in times of happiness. We are called to prepare ourselves to and for prayer, as if it’s the last time we can pray, and that we need to demonstrate proper acts of reverence to prayer.

Silentium magnum (great silence) was cited as a profound and deep spiritual communion with God. It is a moment of emptying ourselves with the secular world and allowing ourselves to come wholly to God. St. Joseph, (whose feast was celebrated the following day) was mentioned as a man of silence and meekness, presents an exemplary model of our Christian values: obedience and humility. Through silent prayer, our expression of faith combined with our charitable works for the poor will pave the way for the development of LOVE without LIMITS in this world, and for us to live a life wholeheartedly, purposely and genuinely in love for and with the poor.
